

BELLEVUE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL EMPLOYEE EXPECTATIONS

1. Employees must have a genuine commitment to Jesus Christ. They are expected to model Christ-like behavior and to evidence spiritual fruit consistent with their age and maturity.
2. All employees, custodians, bus drivers, office managers, administrative assistants, bookkeepers, teachers, teacher's assistants, administrators, are servants of the Lord in ministry to BCS families. Each one is to be mindful of the benefit that they provide others and the honor they give to the Lord.
3. In building community at Bellevue Christian, it is important to establish lines of communication that operate in a Biblical fashion. Employees are expected to use the Matthew 18 principle for resolving conflict. Simply put this means: speak first to the person most directly involved, and do not make the circle of knowledge any larger than is necessary to deal with the situation.
4. Employees are expected to work together cooperatively and enthusiastically. Promptness, attending required meetings, encouraging one another and giving and receiving constructive criticism all contribute to a healthy working atmosphere.
