

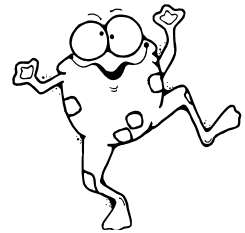
Dear Second Grader,

- # -# Backpack or Bookbag for papers and lunch
- # -# Pencil Box (No large ones please as they don't fit in our desks)
- # -# 2 dozen yellow #2 wood pencils to share — not labeled
- # -# 1 Large Box Kleenex to share — not labeled
- # -# *Girls:* 1 box of gallon Ziploc bags, *Boys:* 1 pkg. paper plates — not labeled
- # *Please label all items (except shared) with your name in permanent marker... Yes, this means every crayon and colored pencil too!*
