- \* students with last name A-H :2 boxes of plastic forks
  - I-P: 1 package of paper napkins
  - Q-Z: 1 package of paper plates
- \*optional: your own scissors (small fiskars), small pencil sharpener, ruler (metric and standard), large pink eraser. (Note: if you bring a pencil box, it should be a small one so it can fit with your books and supplies easily inside your desk.)

Your other supplies will be provided by the school.

I hope you are having a great summer vacation enjoying God's creation, spending time with your family, reading, and maybe traveling to new places or experiencing new things. I'm planning to do some of those same things with my family! When you come to school in the fall, I will be looking forward to meeting you and hearing about your summer!
