Students at Bellevue Christian School are expected to demonstrate a certain level of maturity and responsibility. To demonstrate that we trust our students, BCS allows students, under certain conditions, to leave campus during Thursday's long lunch period. This privilege applies only to Thursdays of each full school week. One of those conditions is parental consent; we urge your careful consideration of the matter. Only those students having a signed permission slip on file will be allowed to leave campus. Parents are expected to instruct their own 9th, 10th and 11th grade student about offering or requesting rides with other students during lunch time.

9TH – 10TH & 11TH GRADES THURSDAY OFF CAMPUS LUNCH POLICY

1. Parents will be notified that BCS will grant off-campus lunch privileges to students who have prior parental permission.
2. A permission form must be filled out, signed by the parent and the student, then returned to the high school office.
3. Any violation of the Thursday Off Campus Lunch Policy will result in loss of off-campus lunch privilege. Examples include,
 - a. going off campus with underclassmen (Junior High students may not leave campus)
 - b. returning late to class after lunch;
 - c. leaving campus without permission at other times, or
 - d. violating the driving/parking regulations listed on the parking permit application,
 - e. speeding on campus.
