SENIOR LUNCH POLICY FORM

Seniors at Bellevue Christian School are expected to demonstrate a certain level of maturity and responsibility. To demonstrate that we trust our seniors, our Senior Lunch Policy grants seniors off campus privileges under certain conditions. One of those conditions is parental consent; we urge your careful consideration of the matter.

SENIOR LUNCH POLICY

1. Parents will be notified that BCS will grant off-campus lunch privileges to seniors who have prior parental permission.
2. A permission form must be filled out, signed by the parent and the senior, then returned to the high school office.
3. Any violation of Senior Lunch Policy will result in loss of off-campus lunch privilege. Examples include,
 - a. going off campus with underclassmen
 - b. returning late to class after lunch;
 - c. leaving campus without permission at other times, or
 - d. violating the driving/parking regulations listed on the parking permit application
 - e. speeding through the parking lots.
