Trip Objectives: *To provide students an opportunity to:* use their giftedness in ministering in an area of interest such as: medical, social work, education, carpentry or other ministry site options; be exposed to Guatemalan culture and people and experience cross-cultural living; process questions like; “What can I learn about myself and God from this experience?” and use the Spanish language in a native setting.

Application Info: Completed applications are due by Friday, Dec. 9th to the high school office. A \$250 deposit check must be attached to the application to be reviewed. Applications are reviewed by trip leaders. Selection of travel team members is determined by trip leaders and BCS reserves the right to decline applicants. Once a student is accepted to the team and signs a “Commitment Contract”, *the \$250 application deposit is non-refundable.* In other instances, deposit checks *will be* returned.

Other: Applicants will be notified of the status of their application on Wednesday, December 14th. Once travel teams are fully determined, team members will receive trip details, meeting and payment schedules, answers to “Frequently Asked Questions”, etc. via mail, email, team meetings and/or the BCS Service and Missions webpage.

IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS RE: JOINING A BCS TRAVEL TEAM

- Accommodations may be humble with the possibility of shared bathrooms, simple beds, cold showers, etc. Food may be unlike what you are accustomed to eating.
- A Passport is required for travel. Immunizations may be required.
- Travel team members are **required** to attend meetings *before, during, and after* travel dates. Absences from meetings **must** be approved by the trip leader **prior** to the meeting date.
- BCS requires team members to sign a commitment contract and a behavior contract.
- BCS requires parents and guardians of travel team members to sign a waiver of liability form.
- Travel team members are required to pay for trip expenses in full, including unforeseen expenses that may arise. BCS is not responsible in any way for expenses related to this trip.
- Travel team members must depart from and return to Seattle with the team.
- Limited team spots are available for this travel team. If selected to join the team, withdrawal from the travel team, failure to make payment deadlines, etc. may in essence have cost another student the opportunity to participate in the trip.
