*Most classes will need a minimum of ten students to be offered. Check with Larry Anderson after June 1 to finalize whether the course will be offered.

Also, for most summer school classes, 3 days of planned absences is the maximum allowed. In Washington State History no absences are allowed because of the required field trips and activities in the twelve continuous day sessions.

This is a one-day workshop which includes a keyboarding/word processing refresher, a study of computer ethics and an introduction to the BCS computer resources. To enroll in class students must have received an A- or higher in a junior high computer block class or the equivalent grade in transferring school. Course ends with competency assessment for those requesting a waiver of the BCS High School computer requirement. Teacher signature is required for enrollment.

Current 8th grade students may be enrolled in math but will not receive high school credit unless a high school credit agreement is signed by both parents and students and submitted before start of class
