## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TUITION SCHEDULE 2012 - 2013 SCHOOL YEAR

<b>APPLICATION FEE:</b> Non-refundable; new applicants only; due with application	\$75 per student
<b>ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE:</b> Non-refundable; due at acceptance/re-enrollment	\$500 per student
<b>BUILDING FEE:</b> Non-refundable; due at acceptance/re-enrollment	\$750 per family

**ANNUAL TUITION:** A graduated tuition schedule applies to families with more than one K-12 students. "1st" is the student in the highest grade, "2nd" the next oldest and so on.

### **ANTICIPATED FEES:**

**Textbooks** are purchased through the University Bookstore in Bellevue. \$200 - \$400  
(Books may be returned for credit.)

**Course fees** for elective courses (see student handbook) \$10 - \$150 per course

**Athletic fee** (per sport, capped at 2 sports) \$150

Other possible costs include individual/group photographs, student retreats and social events, band and choir tour expenses, field trips and 8th grade state trip.

### **TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

- Full annual tuition may be paid by July 1, 2012 with a 2% discount if paid by check.
- Full annual tuition may be paid by July 1, 2012 by credit card or by wire transfer without a discount.
- Tuition and ELL can be made in two installments. Payments are due for first semester by July 1, 2012 and second semester is due by January 1, 2013.

### **PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- Once accepted the registration fee and building fee must accompany the registration forms.
- Tuition account must be current for a student to start school.
- If the tuition becomes past due, student(s) may be asked to not return to school until account is brought current.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- A \$50 late fee will be charged to accounts that become 30 days past due.

**Students who withdraw after the semester starts are required to pay tuition for the full semester in which they withdraw.**
