To get us started everyone needs to bring these things to the Family/Student Visitation Day on Friday, August 26th from 1 – 2:00 p.m. or on the first day of school:

Please bring in the following for the whole class to share together:

- **24- #2 *sharpened* yellow pencils**
- **3 - pink pearl erasers**
- **24 – pink pencil cap erasers**
- **2 - large *white* glue sticks (not purple, not re-stickable)**

On these items make sure your name is on EVERYTHING listed below, including all the individual crayons!

- **1- box of crayons – no more than 24 (Twistables work well)**
- **1 - colored pencils – no more than 18 (Twistables work well)**
- **1 - broad tipped colored markers – no more than 12**
- **2- black fine tip (not ultra fine) Sharpie markers**
- **1- pair 7” student scissors (no round tipped or plastic blades)**
- **1 - pencil box to hold above supplies (5”x13”x3” fits well)**
- **1 - box of watercolors - 8 count only (Crayola works best)**
- **1-letter-sized clipboard**
- **2-plastic folders *with pockets* in different colors or designs (no center prongs)**
- **1 - spiral bound, wide margin, 70 page, one subject notebook**
- **1- backpack for transporting materials to and from school (no wheels please)**
- **\$20.00 student activity fee - checks payable to BCS**

Each day you will need to bring a *lunch*, a *nutritious snack* and a favorite book for you to read during silent reading. School will begin on Monday, August 29th. It is important that we begin our day right at 8:30 AM. So, please plan to come a little early so you have time to put your lunch away and to put your school things in your desk.
