PERMISSION FORM TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS USING NON-BCS OWNED VEHICLE

IMPACT AND SIGNIFICANCE FOR BCS, PARENTS AND STUDENTS

1. When non-school vehicles are used as transportation to and from BCS events, games and/or practices, the vehicles owner's insurance carrier has primary responsibility in settling any claim losses.
2. Whenever possible, BCS employees, parents and students should use school vehicles.
3. Parent(s) of driving student must complete the top half of this Form acknowledging that there will be other students riding with their son/daughter and that the insurance on the student's vehicle is primary in this case. Parent(s) of driving student must also confirm that they carry a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 bodily injury liability and \$100,000 property damage or \$300,000 combined single limits bodily/property coverage on the vehicle to be used.
4. Parents of non-driving student must complete the bottom half of this Form acknowledging that their student will be riding with a driving parent/student and releasing BCS from any resulting liability.

Expectations of BCS Student Drivers

1. All driving done by BCS students must be in a way that abides by Washington State Law.
2. All driving must abide by rules and regulations listed in the BCS Handbook.
3. Any reckless driving / horseplay by BCS student drivers or reckless behavior/ horseplay by passengers in vehicles to and from games and / or practices will result in BCS discipline and could result in removal from BCS athletic teams.
