CHICKEN POX VACCINATION

The Washington State Board of Health requires the Chicken Pox Vaccine (Varicella) for all kindergarten and sixth grade students. As of the fall of 2006, all students **entering Sixth grade** must have a Chicken Pox Vaccination (Varicella) before school starts, **or** provide information of when the student had Chicken Pox **or** why the family is choosing not to immunize for Chicken Pox. Additionally, we need to know the date of your sixth graders last tetanus shot.

THIS COMPLETED FORM MUST BE RETURNED TO THE MACK OFFICE ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

- **If your sixth grade student has had the Varicella vaccine**, please indicate below, the date they had the vaccine.
- **If they have had the Chicken Pox disease**, please indicate the approximate date or age on the line indicated.
- **If your chose not to have your student(s) vaccinated** for Varicella (Chicken Pox), please fill complete and sign the bottom portion of this form.
