# Mrs. Fish's Fourth Grade School Supply List

Please put your name on every item with a permanent marker, and bring everything with you on the first day of school or on the visiting day before school starts.

- 1 package of wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 notebooks
- 1 accordion-style expanding file folder  
(7 slots maximum)
- 1 three-ring binder with outside plastic sleeve (1½ inches)
  
- 1 pencil box
- 2-3 dozen sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 large erasers
- 1 large box of colored pencils
- 1 box of markers
- 1 pair of scissors
- At least 4 glue sticks
- 1 package of fine-tip dry erase markers (low odor)
  
- USB flash drive (8GB)
- 1 box of tissues (You don't need your name on this one ☺)
