2019-20 School Supply List for Grades K-6

Please note: this is a general list of supplies. Individual teachers may request additional supplies when class assignments are completed in August.

K – 6

All Kindergarten through 6th grade students need to bring a sketchbook. Here is the link to the preferred sketchbook from Target:

Kindergarten

For your child (please label each item with your child's name):

- 1 backpack (no wheels) that is large enough to fit a daily folder inside.
- (2) 1/2 inch wide, white 3-ring binders with clear view pocket in front AND include about 20 protective sheets per binder for their memory books.
- 1 complete change of clothing (including socks!) in a 1 gallon freezer bag. Please label with name and plan to change out the clothing half way through the year as Kindergarteners grow fast!

For community supplies (do not label with your child's name):

- 8 LARGE/JUMBO glue sticks –Elmer's Xtreme brand – no disappearing glue, please.
- 2 sturdy folders with pockets - a special design of their choosing (no center prongs)
- 1 Crayola watercolor paint set
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of triangular crayons (8 or 16 count)
- 3 packages of baby wipes (for hands and cleaning desks)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- Plastic ware (spoons and forks, no knives)

*Pencils and scissors will be provided by the school.

Each day you will need to send a lunch and a nutritious snack. Please do not include items like candy or pop. Children may bring in lunch items to be heated in the microwave for one minute or less. We would also like to encourage you to bring a reusable water bottle that can go home each Friday to be washed.

1st Grade

Mark your name clearly on these items:

- 2 current photographs of you (for class projects—will not be returned)
- 1 school/pencil box (for colored pencils, crayons, and markers, etc.)
- 1 backpack or large tote bag (No wheels, please.)
- 2 pocket folders
- 1 - pair 7" student scissors (no round tipped or plastic blades)
- 1 box crayons (24 count only)
- 1 box of colored pencils (standard, primary colors only)
- 1 box wide-tip, washable, colored markers (8-10 count only)
- 3 white board markers, your choice of color (no fine tip)
- 1 black fine-tip Sharpie (no extra fine)

Do not mark your name on the following items. Please leave all items in their original boxes:

- 2 - large white glue sticks
- 1 box Kleenex
- 3 packages of Baby wipes (for wiping desks)
- Snack, Gallon, or Quart-size Ziploc storage bags

We will let you know if we need to re-supply any of these items during the school year.

2nd Grade

Please bring in the following for the whole class to share together:

- 12 - #2 sharpened yellow pencils
- 3 - large white glue sticks
- 1 – box of tissues

EVERYTHING listed below will be yours and kept in your desk:

- 1 - box of crayons – no more than 24
- 1 – box of colored pencils – no more than 12 (Twistables work well)
- 1 – box of broad tipped colored markers – no more than 12
- 2 - black fine tip (not ultra-fine) Sharpie markers
- 3 – dry erase pens – different colors
- 2 - pink pearl erasers
- 1 - pair 7” student scissors (no round tipped or plastic blades)
- 1 - pencil box to hold the above supplies (5”x13”x3” is a suggestion)
- 1 – set of watercolor paints – 8 colors. Crayola is a good quality.
- 2 - plastic folders with pockets in different colors or designs (no center prongs)
- 1 - spiral bound, wide margin, 70 page, one subject notebook
- 1 - backpack for transporting materials to and from school (no wheels please)

Each day you will need to bring a lunch, a nutritious snack and a favorite book for you to read during silent reading

3rd Grade

- 4 (red, blue, yellow and one a student choice) pocket folders each with 2 pockets, no brands or center prongs.
- 1 Composition notebook
- 1 package of wide-rule loose leaf notebook paper
- 1 hard cover pencil box (about 9” by 6” – not too big)
- 2 dozen sharpened #2 pencils to use throughout the year (Dixon Ticonderoga hold up well!)
- Erasers – two erasers
- 2 green ballpoint pens
- 2 large glue sticks (marked with name)
- 3-4 Expo Dry Erase Markers
- Scissors (marked with name)
- Colored pencils 12 ct. (twistables work well!)
- 1 clipboard (letter size)
- Box of tissues

*** Bring the following if you already have them! 😊 ***

- Coloring markers
- An extra package of wide rule paper and/or pencils

4th Grade

- 1 expanding file folder for all subjects (accordion style) - 7 slots maximum.
- 1 binder with outside plastic sleeve (1 ½ inch)
- One thumb drive to save your work to throughout the year. Please write your initials on the flash drive with sharpie (8 GB recommended)
- 2 single-subject notebooks
- 1 package of wide ruled notebook paper
- 1 pencil box or case
- 2 dozen sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 larger erasers
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of markers
- 1 pair of scissors
- At least 4 glue sticks
- 1 package of fine tipped dry erase markers- low odor
- Box of tissues

5th Grade

Please label each item with student name and bring the first day of school.

- Bring the ESV Bible you were given by the school (for memory work).
- 1 soft, zippered binder with 2" (or larger) rings.
- 1 three-subject, college-ruled, 3-hole punched spiral notebook
- 1 hard-cover pencil box, approximately 11" X 8". If you can't find one locally, it can be ordered from Amazon.com or <http://tinyurl.com/GibbsPencilBox>
- 12 sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 Pilot Precise V7 Rolling Ball Pens in black, fine point
- 1 box of sharpened colored pencils (approx. 12 colors)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 package Expo Dry Erase Fine Point Markers (avoid yellow because it doesn't show up well)
- Small manual pencil sharpener
- 4 GB or larger flash drive
- 1 package of 4" X 6" lined note cards
- 1 box of tissues
- Pad of small sticky notes for bookmarking pages
- Headphones or earbuds

Students do NOT need tape, crayons, white-out, or folders.

6th Grade

- Backpack (no rolling)
- 1 – 1 ½ inch binder with dividers OR expanding file folder, NO zippered binders
- 2 – one subject spiral notebooks, college ruled (yellow & orange)
- 1 package of college ruled notebook paper (to share)
- 24 sharpened #2 pencils
- 2 super fine point Sharpie black pens
- 1 package of fine point markers- (Crayola)
- 3 ballpoint pens for correcting (any color, not black)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 package Expo markers (eraser optional)
- 1 glue stick (permanent, not washable)
- 1 set of watercolors (Crayola are best)
- 1 adult size scissor
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 clipboard
- Kleenex box to share
- Plastic ware (forks, spoons, plates, napkins) to share
- Bible that you were given by the school (BCS provides for new students)
- 1 pencil container (needs to be able to hold all supplies)
- Plastic ware (spoons and forks, no knives), napkins, and plates to share
