




Dear Second Grader,

- ♥ [Scissors](#) (sharp with rounded point)
- ♥ 2 [Large Pink Erasers](#)
- ♥ 2 [Large Paste Glue Sticks](#)
- ♥ 1 [Box \(24 Count\) Crayons, \*not washable\*](#)
- ♥ 1 [Box \(24 Count\) Colored Pencils](#)
- ♥ 2 [folders with bottom pockets](#)
- ♥ Backpack or Bookbag for papers and lunch
- ♥ 1 [Pencil Box](#) (No giant ones please as they don't fit in our desks but still big enough to hold crayons, colored pencils, erasers, scissors & glue sticks.)
- ♥ 1 [Dozen yellow #2 wood pencils to share](#) – not labeled
- ♥ Last name A-M: 1 container of Clorox wipes to share, Last name N-Z: 1 pkg of 100 paper plates to share (the cheap ones with ruffled edges)
- ♥ ***Please label all items (except shared items) with your name in permanent marker... Yes, this means every crayon and colored pencil too!***
