### Description

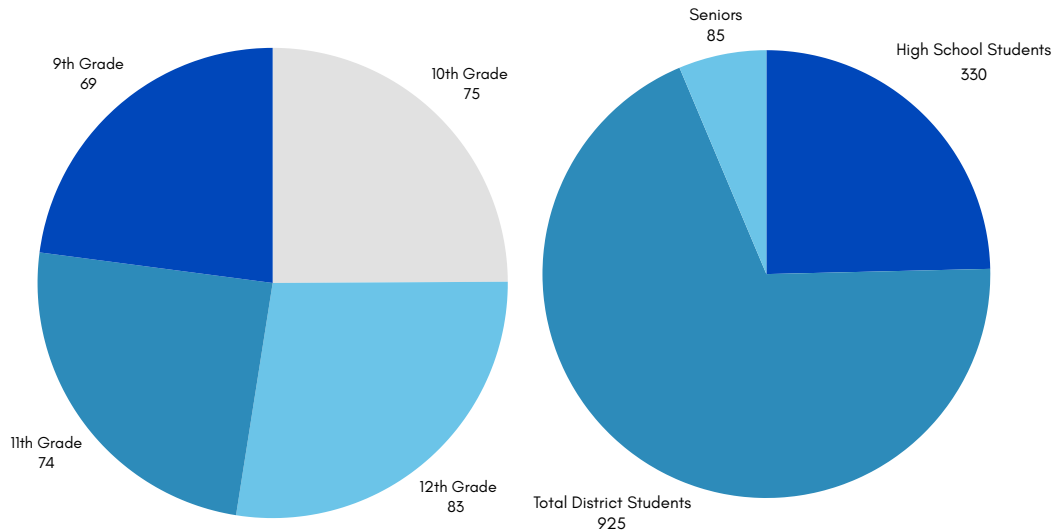

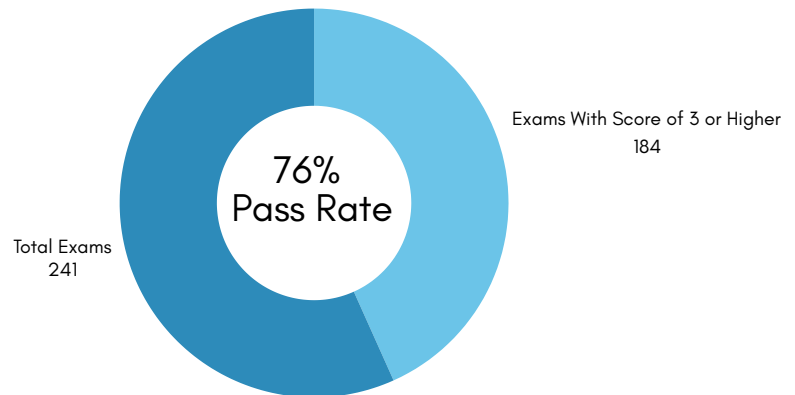
