



Scott Bioren Memorial Scholarship Application Cover Sheet

Scott Bioren attended BCS from 2nd grade until his graduation in 1988. He felt a strong attachment to the BCS community as a student and alumnus. He was grateful for the opportunity to be educated at BCS and to benefit from, and to contribute to, the community after graduation. He had a particular fondness for the BCS soccer program both as a player (elected captain and MVP) and later as a coach leading BCS to two state championships.

On August 16, 1995, while building flight hours by riding in the cockpit of a routine commercial air cargo flight, an uncontrollable fire in the right engine of the aircraft resulted in the downing of the plane and the taking of Scott's life. This scholarship is made possible by the gracious contributions of many people who knew Scott personally and those who desire to help provide financial assistance to students and families who desire a BCS education and have an interest or gifting in soccer or other athletic programs.

Scott Bioren Memorial Scholarship criteria:

- Will be a grade 9-12 student at BCS for upcoming school year
- Essay describing the student's faith journey and desire for a BCS education, and demonstrating:
 - ✓ Active participation in BCS athletic team. Or if unsupported by BCS, another local athletic team (for example, swim).
 - ✓ Academic excellence and work ethic
- Recommendation from BCS team coach (or outside team coach if BCS does not support that sport)

Application deadline is 3:00 pm, April 15 (or the immediate school day following if April 15 falls on a holiday or weekend). Application must be received in Finance office by this deadline; application steps below must be complete for scholarship application to be considered.

Application Steps:

1. Parent or guardian must have submitted a fully complete application for Tuition Assistance by the April 15 deadline.
2. Student will write an original, personal essay which incorporates all 4 prompts:
 - What difference does knowing Jesus make in your life?
 - Why does a faith-based education matter to you?
 - Tell us what you do to accomplish your academic and other goals.
 - Tell us about your participation on a BCS (or other non-BCS sport) athletic team.Essay must be your personal story and not product of AI. Essay will be no longer than two pages and should follow the APA Style.
3. One coach recommendation articulating the student's participation and contribution in soccer or other athletic program. Coach recommendation may be submitted separately but must be submitted by application deadline.
